 - Hinduphobia, fear of Hindus or Hinduism;


What is there to be so scared about the Hindus?

Hindudvesha – A Definition


- Dvesha is a Sanskrit word meaning "aversion", "repulsion" or "hatred" a deep-rooted emotional response that negatively influences one's perception of the world, or something or some phenomena in one's world.
- Hindudvesha, like systemic racism or anti-Semitism, is an <u>ambient</u>, <u>all-encompassing</u> discourse that <u>denigrates</u> and <u>delegitimizes</u> Hinduism and the Hindu people as it relentlessly <u>problematizes</u>, <u>dehumanizes</u>, and <u>demonizes</u> them.
- Its accusatory rhetoric treats Hindus as objects or patients to be examined and diagnosed. It presupposes and concludes that something about the Hindus and Hinduism is irredeemably bad and wrong, evil, and demonic.

Hindudvesha – A colonial era example

Hindus are "imperfect, barbaric, savage, wild, vague, wavering, obscure, rude, primitive, regressive, frivolous, wretched, imbecile, mean, absurd, base, gross, monstrous, superstitious, stupid, degraded, hierarchical, oppressive, immoral, disorderly, violent, selfish, corrupt, deformed, disgusting, groveling, ridiculous, inconsistent, incoherent, ignorant, credulous, timid, dirty, weak, given to exaggeration and flattery, engulfed in darkness and confusion, and hardly different from monkeys."

James Mill, History of British India, 1819



Recognizing Hindudvesha – A Checklist

Ser#	Questions	Blatant Hindudvesha	Blind Hindudvesha
1	Are the Hindu People a legitimate people? Do they have a right to live as Hindus?	No. Never.	May be – with an appropriate Oversight
2	Do Hindu traditions and culture have a legitimate place in contemporary society?	Not at all. They need to be destroyed.	May be – But they need to be saved or reformed.
3	Can the Hindu speak up as a Hindu? Or does the Hindu have to be coopted in order to be legitimate?	No. The Hindu voice must be silenced.	May be if they agree and conform
4	To what extent have the problems in Hindu society been caused by Invasions and Colonization?	Not even a little. Such questions are taboo.	Either willfully or blindly never asked.
5	Do all problems in Hindu society today, need to be traced back to some essential aspect of Hinduism?	Yes. Absolutely. It is a core commitment.	Seems like Hinduism is the main problem.
6	Can the problems in Hindu society be addressed by applying principles from within Hinduism?	No. Hinduism needs to be exterminated.	May be. But not without major reform.
7	Are Hindu efforts to recover and restore their lost or damaged traditions, texts and culture legitimate?	No. These efforts must be eliminated.	Only to the extent that they reform & conform.
8	Is there anything positive or valuable that Hinduism has contributed to the world?	Everything positive has to be appropriated.	Very little if anything – mostly accidental.



Academia and Hindudvesha

Holocaust is Sanskrit's fault...

- Western intellectuals have responsibility to actively intervene... to destroy the built-in social poisons in Sanskrit

"Western Echo Chamber"

- Rigidly defined framework for Hindu studies and discourse
- Noncompliant approaches declared unsound and unacceptable
- Hindu intellectuals shunned as "too biased"





Modes of Promoting Hindu-Hatred Employed by Equality Labs

The three modes

- 1. Produce propaganda reports, articles, and hate-oriented artwork
- 2. Leverage social media to spread its hateful propaganda
- 3. Motivate and inspire its social media followers and political allies to weaponize the organization's hateful propaganda

Examples of Propaganda Material Used by Equality Labs

- A dubious 2018 caste report that demeans Hindus and Hinduism
 - O Its Conclusion: There is nothing more to Hinduism than caste

"Caste is a structure of oppression that affects over 1 billion people across the world. It is a system of religiously codified exclusion that was established in Hindu scripture."

 Report includes false and highly-charged accusations about Hindu culture, religion and society

"Caste like race is a social category created in order to exploit a particular group of people. While it shares characteristics that are analogous to class and racial systems of oppression it is quite distinct because of its religious origins and the connections it makes between purity, profession, and skin color."

Forms


- Demeaning and insulting Hindu society and religion

- Stereotyping Hindus as privileged oppressors thereby justifying the hatred and violence directed at them







Mass Media's role in creating Hindudvesha

- Semiotic analysis reveals strategic use of symbolism in creating racial, hateful stereotypes and narratives against Hindus
- Systemic creation of tropes to promote Hindudvesha and stereotypes about Hindus
- Blatant mockery of Hindu tradition and practices which reinforces inferiority complex among younger generations of Hindus, promoting them to distance themselves from the culture
- Dubious and Obvious ways of injecting Hindudvesha into viewers mind

Why does this happen?


- Lack of awareness (in fact support) among Hindus
- Lack of reaction due to fear of labeling
- Systemic, well-funded approach to create institutions & networks with the aim to spread Hindudvesha
- Hindudveshis' confidence over lack of consequences (legal & civilian)


What Can We Do?







Hindudvesha –Informal Stratified Online Survey

84 respondents

- majority were between ages 35-64.
- 03 percent were under 18.
- 65 percent male
- 33 percent female.
- 51 percent Hindu Americans living in the USA.
- 19 percent from India
- 14 percent from the indentured Indian diaspora;
- 7 percent from Canada

Findings

- 15 percent Hindus had a great deal/a lot of awareness of Hindudvesha as expressed in words, writings, actions and behaviors
- 25 percent said the awareness was moderate
- 55 % said Hindus had little awareness of the phenomenon
- 10 percent said they had no awareness.



Hindudvesha – Behaviours and Actions


- Racial Oppression

- American interference in India's policies – congressional hearings and state resolutions
